Dear Mr. Engle:

On July 2, 1998, the Federal Election Commission sent the National Republican Senatorial Committee ("the NRSC") and J. Stanley Huckaby, as treasurer, notification of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, ("the Act"). A copy of this information was faxed to you more recently in light of your apparent failure to have received the earlier mailing.

On February 10, 2000, the Commission found, on the basis of information in the complaint and information provided by you, that there is no reason to believe the NRSC and Mr. Huckaby, as treasurer, violated any provision of the Act. The Commission has closed the file in this matter. A copy of the First General Counsel's Report is enclosed for your information.

The confidentiality provisions at 2 U.S.C. §437g(a)(12) no longer apply, and this matter is now public. In addition, although the complete file must be placed on the public record within 30 days, this could occur at any time following certification of the Commission's vote. If you wish to submit any factual or legal materials to appear on the public record, please do so as soon as possible. While the file may be placed on the public record before receiving your additional materials, any permissible submission will be added to the record upon receipt.
