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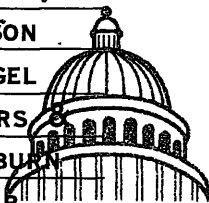

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**CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTION**

In consideration for the Federal Election Commission granting an extension to respond to the General Counsel's Brief in this matter, respondents, California Democratic Party, Democratic State Central Committee of California Federal, and Katherine Moret, as treasurer, Democratic State Central Committee of California Non-Federal, and Katherine Moret, as treasurer, hereby consent to extend the statute of limitations of any civil enforcement action that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MUR 4788 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(6), for a period equal to twenty (20) days, the number of days for which an extension is sought. This action will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement action in connection with MUR 4788 by the same period mentioned above from the expiration of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in these matters.
