- (e) Respondents by income level:** The categories are 'Less than \$10,000', '\$10,000-\$20,000', '\$20,000-\$30,000', '\$30,000-\$40,000', '\$40,000-\$50,000', '\$50,000-\$60,000', '\$60,000-\$70,000', '\$70,000-\$80,000', '\$80,000-\$90,000', '\$90,000-\$100,000', and 'More than \$100,000'. The percentages are approximately: Less than \$10,000 (10%), \$10,000-\$20,000 (15%), \$20,000-\$30,000 (20%), \$30,000-\$40,000 (15%), \$40,000-\$50,000 (10%), \$50,000-\$60,000 (10%), \$60,000-\$70,000 (10%), \$70,000-\$80,000 (10%), \$80,000-\$90,000 (10%), \$90,000-\$100,000 (10%), and More than \$100,000 (10%).
- (f) Respondents by marital status:** The categories are 'Single', 'Married', 'Divorced', and 'Widowed'. The percentages are approximately: Single (30%), Married (50%), Divorced (15%), and Widowed (5%).
- (g) Respondents by political affiliation:** The categories are 'Democrat', 'Republican', 'Independent', and 'Other'. The percentages are approximately: Democrat (40%), Republican (35%), Independent (15%), and Other (10%).
