On July 22, 1999, the Federal Election Commission reviewed the allegations in your complaint dated September 30, 1998, and found that on the basis of the information provided in your complaint, and information provided by the respondents, there is no reason to believe that North Central Illinois Laborers' District Council Political Action Committee ("NCILDC PAC"), the seven named members of the NCILDC PAC Executive Board or the sixteen named Laborers' Local Unions which participate in the NCILDC PAC violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b.

Accordingly, on July 22, 1999, the Commission closed the file in this matter. A copy of the General Counsel's Report is enclosed for your information.

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(8).
