Dear Ms. Smith:

As we discussed, this letter will constitute my response pursuant to the October 30, 1998 letter to me from F. Andrew Turley and the complaint in the referenced matter. As I advised you I have no knowledge concerning the facts that are alleged in the complaint. My knowledge is limited to the fact that my wife and I made two campaign contributions to the Udall for Congress Campaign. The first contribution by check #1137 in the amount of \$250 was made on May 19, 1997 in connection with the primary election. Our second contribution was by check #192 in the amount of \$1,000 on October 13, 1998 and was made in connection with the general election. As far as I know, these contributions comply with the limits for campaign contributions.

You advised me that at this point the Staff of the Federal Election Commission has not determined whether it will pursue an investigation of this matter and that the matter may not be pursued. The Udall Committee advises me that an amended response has been filed to clear up this matter. You also advised me that this response in the form of a letter was satisfactory insofar as I am concerned. Please let me know if you require anything further of me. I would appreciate receiving confirmation of the dismissal of this matter. Thank you.
