III. BACKGROUND: Failure to Timely File the 1998 March Monthly and 1998
April Monthly Reports

The Kansas City Southern Industries Inc Employees Political Action Committee ("KCSI PAC") has failed to timely file the 1998 March Monthly Report of Receipts and Disbursements covering the period from February 1, 1998 through February 28, 1998 and the 1998 April Monthly Report of Receipts and Disbursements covering the period from March 1, 1998 through March 31, 1998.

KCSI PAC was notified on December 29, 1997 and February 13, 1998 that the 1998 March Monthly Report was due on March 20, 1998 and that the 1998 April Monthly Report was due on April 20, 1998 (Attachment 2).

A Non-File Notice referencing the 1998 March Monthly Report was sent to KCSI PAC on April 8, 1998 (Attachment 3). A Non-Filer Notice referencing

the 1998 April Monthly Report was sent to KCSI PAC on May 13, 1998 (Attachment 4). Both notices were sent by mailgram.

The Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst telephoned Mr. Linas K. Cesonis, the treasurer, on June 11, 1998. Mr. Cesonis stated that the reports were mailed to the Commission on June 8, 1998 (Attachment 5). The 1998 March Monthly Report and 1998 April Monthly Reports were received on June 16, 1998 (Attachment 6).
