

BACKGROUND

ر د On August 3, 1978, the Commission found reasonable cause to believe that the respondent committees violated 2 U.S.C. §433(b)(2) for their failure to declare their affiliation with one another. A conciliation agreement was also approved on that date (the pertinent part is attached as Attachment I).

ANALYSIS

Since this time the Office of General Counsel has been conciliating with the respondents' attorney. The attached conciliation agreement represents the finalized version with a few modifications of the original. The following changes were made to the August 3, 1978 conciliation agreement (see Attachment I):

1. First paragraph A on page 2

The clause, "With the exception of Florida Citizens for Better Government and Concerned Citizens of Florida ..." has been added to the beginning of this paragraph. These two committees did in fact declare their affiliation with one another in their statements of organization.

2. Second paragraph A on page 2

The clause, "Based upon the advice of their legal counsel, respondents' organization and contributors pattern caused them without intent to be in violation of ..." has been added to the beginning of this paragraph. While there has been no evidence of respondents' intent here, their actions were based on the advice of their legal counsel. This section amounts to an admission of the violation.

3. Paragraph B on page 2

Insert this clause in place of the original: "Respondents agree within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement to file Amended Statements of Organization indicating their affiliation with one another." In light of the fact that respondents' activities were caught at such an incipient stage and because no excessive contributions were made by respondents, the civil penalty has been deleted in favor of the above language.

In consideration of the above facts, the Office of General Counsel recommends approval of the attached conciliation agreement.

On May 3, 1978, the Commission found reason to believe that the above named committees are in violation of 2 U.S.C. \$433(b)(2) for their failure to disclose their affiliation with one another.

ANALYSIS

Since this date, a number of communications between the Office General Counsel and the respondent's attorney have taken place. The respondent's position is that the similarities in the mailings and in the reports of the committees can be attributed to the fact that they are all clients of one law firm, Baskin and Sears. Concerning the similarities in contributions to the committees, it was explained that potential contributors ask John Sears of Baskin and Sears for guidance as to how to get involved in the political process. Apparently Sears would refer them to these committees.

As for their financial activity, the total collected by them amounted to nearly \$33,000. The highest collected by any one committee was \$5,605.00 while the lowest was \$350.00. According to quarterly reports for July 10, 1978, eleven of the committees still in existence at that time were terminated. (One committee terminated on May 22, 1978 with no activity and a zero balance and one committee has not yet filed a quarterly report.) These latest reports also reveal that the committees made contributions of \$1000 or less to a wide variety of candidates and committees, thereby reducing their cash on hand to zero. No single candidate or committee is receiving in excess of \$1000 from the respondents.

It should be noted that if the situation had not come to the attention of the Commission, it is possible that much larger amounts of money could have been accumulated and subsequently contributed by the committees. Since they were scattered throughout the country, it would have been difficult to gather them together in order to make the comparisons which were made (see the General Counsel's Report certified on May 3, 1978). Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission find reasonable cause to believe the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. \$433(b)(2). However, in light of the fact that this activity was discovered in its early stages, we recommend that the Commission approve the attached conciliation agreement with a civil penalty of \$50.00 for each committee.

Pursuant to our various discussions and letters on MUR490-(78), I am reducing to writing the basic reasons why I very strongly feel no action should be taken by the Commission. By no action I mean no conciliation agreement or fine. Our clients, as I previously indicated, would be willing, however, to amend their Registration Statements to indicate affiliation; though this willingness is reluctant since they do not believe themselves affiliated with anybody. Such an amendment would, I think, be a fair settlement to this matter and serve the interest of the law.

To summarize our reasons why MUR490-(78) should be dismissed I note first that the good faith of the committees is apparent on the face of their reports. The committees reported every single contribution, even those of \$100 or below. Much of the commonality of contributions, such as existed, came to light because the committees were totally open. If some evil design or secret plan of affiliation were involved these committees could easily have accomplished it by not reporting those contributions, as they had a legal right to do. This, of course, was not done.

Second, if affiliation is involved here, it comes about by operation of law, not conscious design. These committees and treasurers were a disparate group. None had

BASKIN & SEARS Christopher Tow, Esquire July 29, 1978 Page Two any reason to believe or any way of knowing that they were or might be considered affiliated. They didn't know each other in most instances. The commonality came from most knowing of John P. Sears of our firm and using him as a lwayer. the extent that several individuals gave money to more than one of the committees is explained by two causes: (1) knowing various persons in the other committees; and (2) seeking Mr. Sears' advice on what other PACs were available to contribute I am sure that many of these individuals gave other contributions, not in question here, to various other PACs and candidates not reported by our firm. If the mere giving of advice to a client on what PACs were available to contribute to constitutes affiliation, then this should be put down in prospective regulation, not made the basis of retroactive complaints. While clearly I see the complaint of the Commission in this case, the Commission must recognize the very difficult problem this client creates for a new firm and its clients. Our clients, acting upon the legal advice of our firm, the best advice we could garner from the regs and the Act, and having no possible way of knowing any relationship they might have with any other committee did not indicate affiliation on their Registration Statements. If this action is now made the basis of a punative complaint proceeding, the client has every reason to believe he or she was trapped by the law. While an amended statement may be quite proper, a conciliation agreement or fine would be most unfair, as well as raising basic problems about the limits of the attorney-client relationship. As previously reported, the Commission found reason to believe on May 3, 1978, that the above named committees are in violation of 2 U.S.C. \$433(b)(2) for their failure to disclose their affiliation with one another. An interim report was distributed to the Commission on a no-objection basis on June 1, 1978.

Since the last report, there have been a number of communications between Loren Smith, attorney for the respondent committees, and the Office of General Counsel. Smith has indicated that the committees will declare their affiliation if the Commission will close this matter. Mr. Smith has not yet communicated an acceptable defense to the Commission's finding of reason to believe a violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(2) was committed by his client committees.

In light of these facts, we stated to Smith our position in a June 21, 1978 telephone conversation. Smith was informed that the Office of General Counsel will recommend that the Commission find reasonable cause to believe a violation of 2 U.S.C. \$433(b)(2) has occurred in this matter unless he is able to provide evidence why such a determination should not be made. He expressed his understanding of this and agreed to mail a letter sometime this week explaining specifically why the committees are not affiliated.

The Office of General Counsel is presently awaiting this letter and will recommend an appropriate action after it has been received and assessed.

UPDATE SUMARY

Reporting Matters:

Since the first report on matters relating to MUR \$490, all of the committees involved have filed reports covering the activity 1/1/78-3/31/78(the April 10 Quarterly Report). In one instance, Taxpayers Allied for Good Government (Committee L), they filed a Termination Report including all activity since 1/1/78 up to 5/15/78.

In addition, several RFAIs were sent by the Mon-Party Team relating to inadequacies discovered on the Year End Reports and responses were received from the committees. Also a few RFAIs were sent relating to the 1st Quarter Report, but no responses have been received as of yet.

Findings related to 1st Quarter Reports:

The 1st Quarter Reports were notably similar, in listing \$50 as unitemized operating expenditures. A conversation with an attorney from the law firm of Baskin and Sears, in response to an RFAI sent relating to the 1st Quarter Report revealed that the \$50 represented attorney fees.

Findings related to responses to RFAIs for Year End Reports:

In all cases, in which RFAIs were sent relating to the Year End Report, we received back answers with a Washington D.C. Postmark. In addition, in each case, the Treasurer failed to sign the response.

Contributor Information:

There are now a total of 50 contributors to the committees, of which 12 appeared on 1st Quarter Report for the first time.

Pursuant to our telephone discussion on Thursday, June 1, we have consulted with our clients over MUR 490 (78). There was some strong reluctance on their part to amend their various Registration Statements, as they do not believe themselves to have been affiliated with any other political committees at any time. There was also some concern that such amendments might indicate that they were guilty of some sort of wrong, by not including affiliation in the first filing, even though they were and are convinced that their initial filing was correct.

As counsel, however, we have advised them that this area of the law and rules are somewhat complex and tricky. And we have explained that it is not a matter of quilt or innocence, but merely a technical matter of providing the Commission and the public with the greatest amount of disclosure possible. Thus, we have advised them to amend the various Registration Statements to read as if the committees were in fact affiliated. Our clients have agreed to this in the interests of wrapping up MUR 490(78) and providing the Commission with the fullest possible information. We have further informed our clients that their amendments in no way indicate any wrong on their part in filing their initial Registration Statements, which were done in good faith.

This letter is written to clearly allay any concerns of ours or our clients in the filing of our Registration Amendments. As we discussed in our first meeting, I think our mutual concern is

The Commission found reason to believe on May 3, 1978, that the above-named committees are in violation of 2 U.S.C. \$433(b)(2) for their failure to disclose affiliated and/or connected organizations. The appropriate letters were mailed to the respondent committees.

On May 11, 1978 Mr. Loren Smith contacted the Commission about MUR 490. Smith, an attorney, is a consultant in election law for the firm of Baskin and Sears. After a number of conversations, Smith stated that he was representing nine of the thirteen committees which had received reason to believe notifications from the Commission. He added that he may be representing "all others in MUR 490" also. Pursuant to a

telephone conversation on May 24, 1978, which stated that he will be sending a written response to the Commission's reason to believe notification letter before the end of the week.

We are awaiting this response.

The Reports Analysis Division is presently reviewing the April 10, 1978 quarterly reports of the respondent committees and is making comparisons of committee contributors and compiling other similarities. Their determinations should be ready shortly.

Pursuant to our meetings on Thursday, May 11 and Thursday, May 18, I am writing this letter in order to expedite the proceedings in MUR 490 (78). As noted previously, I represent the attached list of political committees for the firm. I believe that most, if not all, of these committees are included in MUR 490 (78). If there are any other committees involved in MUR 490 (78) I would hope you would so inform me of that fact (not by names). I feel this would not violate the Act's confidentiality provisions.

As to the essence of the matter being investigated, the Commission is inquiring into whether any of the listed PACs are affiliated within the meaning of \$100.14(c) of the Regs. If this is not a correct statement of the inquiry, please let me know. Based on my understanding of \$100.14(c), with the exception of the two PACs in Florida, none of the committees have any indicia of affiliation. This is why they do not list any affiliation with either each other or any of the group. As noted orally, they would each probably be very surprised if we, as their counsel, informed them that they were affiliated with another group. The commonality which I presume led to this inquiry is rooted in the fact that we, as their counsel, used common forms and procedures to file and report for these committees.

We are most anxious to expedite this matter and get if off our desks as the total money raised for all purposes by any of these committees does not justify a very extensive legal fee. 



General Counsel's Report

Background

0

As set forth in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 3, 1978, it was alleged that a number of committees were being formed in conjunction with one another for the common purpose of funneling contributions to certain federal candidates. Certain similarities among the committees' registration statements were pointed out. Also, the report indicated that this activity might constitute a violation of several sections of the Act including 2 U.S.C. §433(b)(2) for failure to disclose affiliated and/or connected organizations. It was recommended that the Commission

await the committees' responses to the Requests for Additional Information sent by the Reports Analysis Division. Since the filing of this First General Counsel's Report, 8 more similar committees have registered bringing the total to 13. In addition, Reports Analysis has received responses to their previous requests and has completed a comparison of the 13 committees pointing out similarities in their organization, their contributors, and their correspondence. Preliminary Legal Analysis O 2 U.S.C. \$433(b)(2) requires that a political committee V registering with the Commission include in the contents of its Statement of Organization the names, addresses, and relationships of affiliated or connected organizations. Also, 11 C.F.R. \$100.14(c) defines an affiliated committee as one established, financed, maintained, or controlled by the same corporation, labor organization, person, or group of persons, including any parent, subsidiary, branch, C. division, department, or local unit thereof. Indicia of "establishing, 1 financing, maintaining or controlling" include similar patterns of contributions to the committees. 11 C.F.R. \$100.14(c)(ii)(D). In their Statements of Organization, the committees left blank the spaces provided for indicating affiliation. Later, in their responses to the Requests for Additional Information, the committee treasurers stated that the space for listings of affiliated and connected organizations should be answered "none." An overview of the comparisons between the respondent committees compiled by Reports Analysis reveals many similarities.

Most prominent of these are: Statements of Organization a) All were filed at approximately the same time. b) No responses were made by any of the respondents to questions 5, 6, 8, 9, and 15 c) The answers to duration of committee existence for question 13 are idantical -- "indefinite existence." d) Similarity in Committee names. e) The dates for question 3 are identical -- "December 26, 1977" for 12 of the 13 committees. f) The responses to question number 2 are identical--C "Not Assigned" for 12 of the 13 committees. J g) The names of the banks for 10 of the 13 respondent 0 committees in question 14 were handwritten whereas the rest of the report was typewritten. One com-mittee had no bank and no treasurer listed. committees listed banks in typewritten form. Similarities in Contributions a) 9 out of 10 of the individuals itemized contributing more than \$100 were doctors in all respondent committees' year end reports. C b) Over 75% of all contributors listed on the respondent committees' year end reports were disclosed by at least two different committees. c) All contributors who gave to more than one of the respondent committees gave to each committee they contributed to the same amount on the same day. In particular, Helen Gray (Treasurer of the "Concerned Pennsylvania Taxpayers Committee") was disclosed in all year end reports for contributing \$100 on 12/26/77. Similarities in responses to our Requests for Additional Information by 11 of 13 committees a) Similar style of writing. b) Identical closing sentence and identical opening lines. c) No dates typed on any of the letters.

In light of these facts, it appears the committees may be affiliated within the meaning of 11 C.F.R. \$100.14(c). Therefore, the committees may be in violation of 2 U.S.C. \$433(b)(2) for failing to disclose their affiliation with each other or their connection with a parent or umbrella organization.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

This matter came to the attention of the Office of General Counsel through a memorandum from the Deputy Staff Director in which it was alleged that one John Sears was attempting to form a number of committees for the common purpose of funneling contributions to certain Federal candidates. *

This activity might constitute violations of several sections of the Act including 2 U.S.C. § 433(b)(2) for failure to disclose affiliated and/or connected organizations.

Attached to the memorandum was a packet of materials from the Taxpayers Allied for Good Government.* This packet contained an unsigned registration statement, two checks made payable to the committee, a memo with instructions on how to fill out the registration materials, and a note from a Mrs. Barbara Wiseman (proposed treasurer of the committee) to a

Mr. Sears stating that she did not wish to be the committee's tressurer. Apparently Mrs. Wiseman received the packet of meterials from Mr. Sears, then wrote the note declining to be the treasurer of the committee and mistakenly forwarded the packet to the attention of Mr. Sears at the Federal Election Commission.

The registration statement is incomplete and erroneous. It is incomplete in that it is unsigned and lines 5,6,8,9,14, and 15 are blank. It is erroneous in that Mrs. Wiseman's name is listed as the committee's treasurer, when she in fact declined that position. Given these facts, it seems that the registration statement of Taxpayers Allied for Good Government should be removed from the public record.

During the period from January 5 to January 15, 1978, four other similar committees registered with the Commission.

The similarities among the committees' registration statements are as follows:

The attached materials are part of an apparent effort by John Sears to set up political action committees throughout the country. The purpose of these PACs appears to be to act as funnels or conduits for funds for conservative contributors. Basically, the scheme apparently works as follows:

- A. Several committees are set up throughout the country;
- B. Donors are instructed to contribute up to \$5,000 to each of several of these committees in amounts totaling up to \$25,000;
- C. These committees in turn are instructed to contribute to particular candidates, either through a newsletter or verbal instruction.

The attached instructions include an already completed FEC Form 1. The following possible violations may be involved:

- 1. The Committee does not disclose its affiliates on line 6 of Form 1:
- 2. These committees may not be registering on time;
- 3. There may be a failure to disclose earmarked contributions pursuant to 2 U.S.C. 441a(a)(8).

I suggest that a researcher examine whether there are other similar committees and that Steve Mims' group be instructed to watch for similar registrations. There appears to be several distinguishing answers on these statements of organizations. For example, Question 2 is answered as "not assigned"; Question 13 is answered as "the committee has no plans to dissolve"; and several of the other lines are left blank. I am referring this to your attention for consideration as a Matter Under Review. I suggest that you may wish to send the checks and attached note back to Barbara H. Wiseman by registered mail.

The attached materials are part of an apparent effort by John Sears to set up political action committees throughout the country. The purpose of these PACs appears to be to act as funnels or conduits for funds for conservative contributors. Basically, the scheme apparently works as follows:

- A. Several committees are set up throughout the country;
- B. Donors are instructed to contribute up to \$5,000 to each of several of these committees in amounts totaling up to \$25,000;
- C. These committees in turn are instructed to contribute to particular candidates, either through a newsletter or verbal instruction.

The attached instructions include an already completed FEC Form 1. The following possible violations may be involved:

- The Committee does not disclose its affiliates on line 6 of Form 1;
- 2. These committees may not be registering on time;
- 3. There may be a failure to disclose earmarked contributions pursuant to 2 U.S.C. 441a(a)(8).

I suggest that a researcher examine whether there are other similar committees and that Steve Mims' group be instructed to watch for similar registrations. There appears to be several distinguishing answers on these statements of organizations. For example, Question 2 is answered as "not assigned"; Question 13 is answered as "the committee has no plans to dissolve"; and several of the other lines are left blank. I am referring this to your attention for consideration as a Matter Under Review. I suggest that you may wish to send the checks and attached note back to Barbara H. Wiseman by registered mail.



- С. These committees in turn are instructed to contribute to particular candidates, either through a newsletter or verbal instruction.

The attached instructions include an already completed FEC Form 1. The following possible violations may be involved:

Committees do not disclose their affiliates on line 6 of Form 1:

- 2. These committees may not be registering on time;
- 3. There may be a failure to disclose earmarked contributions
 4 2 0.5 c.
 pursuant 441a(a)(8).

I suggest that a researcher examine whether there are other similar committees and that Steve Mims' group be instructed to watch for similar registrations. There appears to be several distinguishing answers on these statements of organizations, such as Question 2 is answered as "not assigned"; Question 13 is answered as "the committee has no plans to dissolve"; and several of the other lines are left blank. I am referring this to your attention for consideration as a Matter Under Review. I suggest that you may wish to send the checks and attached note back to Barbara H. Wiseman by registered mail.
