

Although the complaint filed by the New Hampshire Republican State Committee ("Committee") does not accuse PG&E Corporation or its subsidiary, PG&E Generating Company ("PG&E Gen"), of any wrongdoing in connection with the above-captioned matter, we wanted to comment on certain inaccuracies contained in the Committee's complaint.
