On August 29, 2000, your client, Adrian Plesha, was notified that the Federal Election Commission had found reason to believe that he knowingly and willfully violated 2 U.S.C. § 441h, a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act").


Pursuant to its investigation of this matter, the Commission has issued the attached Subpoena requiring Mr. Plesha to appear and give sworn testimony on Wednesday, May 9, 2001 at 9:30 a.m. which will assist the Commission in carrying out its statutory duty of supervising compliance with the Act.

Pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 111.14, a witness summoned by the Commission shall be paid \$40, plus mileage. Subsequent to the deposition, you will be sent a check for the witness fee and mileage.


