I, Mary W. Dove, Secretary of the Federal Election Commission, do hereby certify that on June 19, 2002, the Commission decided by a vote of 6-0 to take the following actions in MUR 4919:

1. Find probable cause to believe that Adrian Plesha knowingly and willfully violated 2 U.S.C. §441h.
2. Refer Adrian Plesha to the Department of Justice pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §437g(a)(5)(C).
3. Find probable cause to believe that Charles Ball for Congress knowingly and willfully violated 2 U.S.C. §§441d(a) and 441h.
4. Find probable cause to believe that Justin Briggs, as treasurer of Charles Ball for Congress, violated 2 U.S.C. §§441d(a) and 441h.
