I am writing in response to a letter dated August 26, 2003 concerning a \$1000.00 contribution from Gary Tabackman on April 21, 1997 to Nadler for Congress, Inc. The letter from the Federal Election Commission (FEC) states that Audiovox who employed Mr. Tabackman has acknowledged in a conciliation agreement with the Federal Election Commission that it violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, by reimbursing the contribution made by Mr. Tabackman.

I want to stress that no person associated with Nadler for Congress had any knowledge whatsoever with the actions of Audiovox or Mr. Tabackman regarding his contribution to the Committee. The Committee was only first made aware of the actions of Audiovox by the Commission's letter. Thus, following the instructions of the FEC regarding this prohibited contribution, Nadler for Congress has disgorged Mr. Tabackman's \$1000.00 contribution to the U.S. Treasury.
