On October 13, 1999, your client, Gene Stipe, was notified that the Federal Election Commission had found reason to believe that he violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441f and 441a(a)(1)(A), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act").




