This is a follow-up to our telephone discussion on September 18, 2000 and in response to your letter dated September 18, 2000.

As grounds for an extension of time to respond to the Commission's reason to believe findings against your client, Mr. Lowinger, you state that your client's bank has been unable to locate copies of the contribution checks at issue. Accordingly, we have enclosed check copies for your reference.

In our conference call on September 18, 2000, your office requested a copy of the complaint mentioned in the Factual and Legal Analysis. Your client, Mr. Lowinger, is an internally generated respondent who was identified as a result of information ascertained by the Commission carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(2). Your client was not specifically named in the complaint. Thus, we are not providing a copy of the complaint to you.

Finally, as stated in our letter of September 22, 2000, the Office of the General Counsel has granted your extension request and has allowed an extension up to October 6, 2000. Accordingly, your response is due by the close of business on October 6, 2000.
