Correction to July 25, 2000 Reason to Believe Finding

On July 25, 2000, the Commission found reason to believe that Joe Horagh violated 2 U.S.C. § 441f. The correct name of this individual is Joe Hourigan. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission find reason to believe that Joe Hourigan violated 2 U.S.C. § 441f, and approve the revised Factual and Legal Analysis which corrects the name of the respondent.

In addition, on October 30, 2000, the Commission found reason to believe that Heshy Biegeleisen and Joshua Schwartz violated 2 U.S.C. § 441f. *See* Memorandum to the Commission from Lawrence M. Noble and Kim Leslie Bright dated October 24, 2000. The revised Factual and Legal Analyses to correct the names of the respondents should have been approved for Mr. Biegeleisen and Mr. Schwartz. Therefore, this Office recommends that the revised Factual and Legal Analyses be approved.

**RECOMMENDATIONS**

1. Find reason to believe that Joe Hourigan violated 2 U.S.C. § 441f.
2. Approve the attached Factual and Legal Analyses for Joe Hourigan, Heshy Biegeleisen, and Joshua Schwartz.
