On December 17, 2001, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission found probable cause to believe that you violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(1)(A) of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended and 11 C.F.R. § 110.1(b)(1) by making an excessive contribution to Dear for Congress, Inc. However, after considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on February 25, 2003, to take no further action against you, close the file as it pertains to you, and refund the \$2,000 you tendered to the Commission on March 21, 2002 in an effort to conciliate this matter. The refund will be sent separately.

You are advised that the confidentiality provisions of 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12)(A) remain in effect, as this matter is still open with respect to other respondents. The Commission will notify you when the entire file has been closed.
