On July 25, 2000, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that your clients, Tom Hennessey, Connor McHugh, and Frank Nolan, violated 2 U.S.C. § 441f in connection with money order contributions to Dear for Congress. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on June 3, 2004, to take no further action against your clients, and closed the file in this matter.
