Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

As we indicated in our letter dated November 10, 1999, and in our telephone conversation with Ms. Alva Smith on November 12, 1999, only two of the four parties named in the complaint in the above-referenced matter have been served. Specifically, only Mr. Jerome Kohlberg and Mr. Douglas Berman have received the complaint. Campaign for America ("CFA") and Ms. Eileen Capone have not yet been served.

Mr. Kohlberg's and Mr. Berman's responses to the complaint would be due during Thanksgiving week, and CFA's and Ms. Capone's response dates will be established only when (and if) they are served. In light of the upcoming holiday and in order to minimize the administrative inconvenience of filing duplicative and/or multiple responses to the complaint, we request that the two parties who have been served be granted extensions to respond to the complaint until December 8, 1999. We further propose that, if this request is granted, all four parties file a consolidated response on that date, regardless of the date of actual service of the complaint on CFA or Ms. Capone.
