

Dear Mr. Eisenberg:

Enclosed is a copy of a letter dated November 3, 1999, signed by Scott Thomas, Chairman of the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"). The letter notifies you that the Commission has found that there is reason to believe that Friends for Harry Reid and you, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 432(b)(1) and (c)(3), 434(b)(3)(A) and (E), 434(b)(2)(G), and 11 C.F.R. §§ 102.8(a), 104.3(a)(3)(vii)(B) and 104.8(a), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended ("the Act"). Attached is a copy of the Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, and a copy of the Interrogatories and Request for Production of Document. The letter requested a response to the Interrogatories and Request for Production within 30 days.
