SUBJECT: REFERRAL OF THE STATE DEMOCRATIC EXECUTIVE
COMMITTEE OF ALABAMA

This is a combined Non-Filer/Chronic Late Filer referral of the State Democratic Executive Committee of Alabama ("the Committee") for failure to timely file the 1997 Year End Report, 1998 April Quarterly and July Quarterly Reports and for failure to file the 1998 October Quarterly, 30 Day Post-General and Year End Reports of Receipts and Disbursements within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of the Non-Filer Notice.

Subsequent to the sending of the Chronic Late Filer Notice referencing the 1997 Year End and 1998 April Quarterly Reports, the Committee failed to timely file the 1998 July Quarterly Report and failed to file the 1998 October Quarterly, 30 Day Post-General and Year End Reports. According to the 1997-1998 RAD Review and Referral Procedures for Unauthorized Committees (Standards 3 and 4), further examination is required by your office.

The Committee may be referred in Group I for a possible 2 U.S.C. § 438(b) audit covering the 1997-98 election cycle. At this time, most of its audit points are for late - and non-filing; therefore, it may not have a significant enough number of points to be considered for audit.

III. BACKGROUND:

Failure to Timely File Reports and Chronic Late Filing of Reports

The State Democratic Executive Committee of Alabama ("the Committee") has failed to file three (3) Reports of Receipts and Disbursements in a timely manner for the 1997-98 election cycle. The Reports were filed between fifty-two (52) and three hundred sixty-six (366) days late. In addition, the Committee failed to file the 1998 October Quarterly, 30 Day Post-General, and Year End Reports of Receipts and Disbursements (see attached chart).

The Committee was notified of the due date for the 1997 Year End Report in the Prior Notices dated December 30, 1996 and December 29, 1997 (Attachments 2 and 3). This latter Prior Notice also noted the due dates for all 1998 reports. A Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee via mailgram on February 23, 1998, referencing the 1997 Year End Report (Attachment 4).

On March 24, 1998, the Committee filed the 1997 Year End Report which included a cover letter of explanation (Attachment 5). The Executive Director, Mr. Giles

Perkins, explained that the records of the Committee "indicate that we mailed the initial report via certified mail on January 27, 1998. We received the return receipt, which was marked as received by the F.E.C. February 2, 1998. I am sending you a copy of this receipt under separate cover." No certified mail receipt was subsequently received by the Commission.

The Committee was notified of the due date for the 1998 April Quarterly Report in the Prior Notice dated March 20, 1998 (Attachment 6). A Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee via mailgram on May 7, 1998, referencing the 1998 April Quarterly Report (Attachment 7).

On May 29, 1998, a Chronic Late Filer Notice was sent to the Committee for failing to file the 1997 Year End and 1998 April Quarterly Reports in a timely manner (Attachment 8). The Notice advised the Committee that any additional late filing of reports may result in legal enforcement action. Subsequent to the mailing of the Chronic Late Filer Notice, the Committee failed to timely file the 1998 July Quarterly Report and failed to file the 1998 October Quarterly, 30 Day Post-General, and Year End Reports of Receipts and Disbursements.

On June 1, 1998, the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst called the Committee and left a message with Giles Perkins, Executive Director, asking the Committee to file the 1998 April Quarterly Report quickly, preferably via certified mail. The Committee was told that failure to file may result in a fine and/or legal action against the Committee (Attachment 9, Page 1).

The Committee was notified of the due date for the 1998 July Quarterly Report in the Prior Notice dated June 19, 1998 (Attachment 10). A Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee via mailgram on August 7, 1998, referencing the 1998 July Quarterly Report (Attachment 11).

On August 28, 1998, the analyst called the Committee and left a message for Mr. Giles Perkins with Jessica Miller, Assistant Treasurer, who stated that Mr. Perkins, nor any other person of authority, was available. The analyst's message stated that the Committee must file its 1998 July Quarterly and April Quarterly Reports or face possible legal action by the Commission. The analyst left his name and number (Attachment 9, Page 1).

The Committee was notified of the due date for the 1998 October Quarterly Report in the Prior Notice dated September 18, 1998. (Attachment 12) A Non-Filer Notice was

sent to the Committee via mailgram on November 4, 1998, referencing the 1998 October Quarterly Report (Attachment 13).

On December 1, 1998, the analyst called John Saxon, Treasurer of the Committee and left the message that the Committee has failed to file the 1998 October Quarterly, July Quarterly, and April Quarterly Reports. The analyst further stated that failure to file the reports may result in legal action against the Committee. The analyst left his name and phone number (Attachment 9, Page 2).

On December 2, 1998, Mr. Saxon called the analyst. He stated that he got in touch with the staff responsible for the completion of the reports. The staff informed him that the reports were completed and filed with the Commission in a timely way. He mentioned that the Committee had this problem with the 1997 Year End Report but that they were able to demonstrate that the report was filed on time. The analyst informed him that the public record currently discloses Non-Filer Notices sent to the Committee for the omitted reports without responses, and that it would be in the best interest of the Committee if it would respond with the missing reports and certified mail receipts. Mr. Saxon stated that he would make sure that the reports were re-sent, but that he believed and trusted his staff (Attachment 9, Page 2).

The Committee was notified of the due date for the 1998 30 Day Post-General Report in the Prior Notices dated September 30, 1998, and November 5, 1998 (Attachments 14 and 15). A Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee via mailgram on January 6, 1999, referencing the 1998 30 Day Post-General Report (Attachment 16).

On January 29, 1999, the analyst called Mr. Saxon and left a message with his secretary. The analyst informed her that the Committee has failed to file the 1998 30 Day Post-General, October Quarterly, July Quarterly, and April Quarterly Reports. He also informed her that this failure to file may likely result in a fine if the reports are not filed. She said that she understood and that she would call the preparer of reports. The analyst mentioned to her that the Treasurer previously stated that he believes that this person is filing the reports. The analyst suggested that if that is still the view held by the Committee, the Committee should verify the mailing address of the Commission, and remail the omitted reports. The analyst left his name and number for the Treasurer to return the call (Attachment 9, Page 3).

On February 16, 1999, the analyst called Mr. Saxon about the omitted 1998 30 Day Post-General Report. Mr. Saxon said that he was told that the reports were mailed with

their certified mail slips to the Commission last week. The analyst informed him that the reports were not received, and in the past, with the 1997 Year End Report, the certified mail slip never came as promised. The analyst provided Mr. Saxon with the names and coverage dates of all of the missing reports at his request. Mr. Saxon said that he was going to call the State office and complain about the omitted reports. Furthermore, he said that there is a new treasurer, but that he was unsure if the Commission has been notified of the change. The analyst advised him that a treasurer change had not been received by the Commission to date and that the Commission should be advised of a change of treasurer in writing. He agreed (Attachment 9, Pages 3 & 4).

The Committee was notified of the due date for the 1998 Year End Report in the Prior Notice dated December 30, 1998 (Attachment 17). A Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee via mailgram on March 2, 1999, referencing the 1998 Year End Report (Attachment 18).

On March 29, 1999, the analyst called John Saxon regarding the omitted 1998 Year End Report. He said that he was no longer the treasurer, but that he would call Mr. Giles Perkins, Executive Director of the Committee, to figure out what the problem is. He suggested that there should be someone to talk to at the Committee office (Attachment 9, Page 4).

On March 29, 1999, the analyst placed a follow-up call to the Committee office and left a message for Mrs. Miller regarding the omission of reports (Attachment 9, Page 4).

On March 30, 1999, Sara Jane Tackett called the analyst and said that it appears that the Committee has mailed the reports in question. Although she hasn't seen the reports or the certified mail receipts, she was assured that they were mailed, but she will file them again by April 7, 1999. The analyst confirmed the Commission's mailing address with Ms. Tackett and recommended that the Committee begin electronically filing because it is a more reliable method of filing reports. Ms. Tackett responded that the Committee had purchased the upgrade to electronically file reports from Aristotle already and they intend to use it for the 1999 reports (Attachment 9, Page 5).

On April 5, 1999, Ms. Tackett called the analyst and stated that she has concluded that the Committee filed none of the reports for 1998. She stated that she worked at the Committee during the 1996 election cycle and had returned to the Committee to work for

the 2000 election cycle. She was disappointed to learn that she now needed to file the reports for all of 1998. She said that the person whose task it was to prepare the reports has been fired, and the Committee has hired an attorney to get in touch with Lois Lerner of the Office of General Counsel (Attachment 9, Pages 5 & 6).

The Committee filed the 1998 April Quarterly and July Quarterly Reports on April 16, 1999 (Attachments 19 and 20). As of this date, the 1998 October Quarterly, 30 Day Post-General, and Year End Reports of Receipts and Disbursements have not been filed.


