On July 7, 2000, the Commission reviewed the allegations in your complaint dated February 11, 2000, and found that on the basis of the information provided in your complaint, and information provided by Perot '96, Reform Party of the United States of America, and Russell L. Verney, there is no reason to believe that Perot '96 and Michael J. Poss, as treasurer; Reform Party of the United States of America, and Thomas J. McLaughlin, as treasurer; or Russell L. Verney violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 431-455. Accordingly, on July 7, 2000, the Commission closed the file in this matter. A copy of the General Counsel's Report is enclosed for your information.

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(8).
