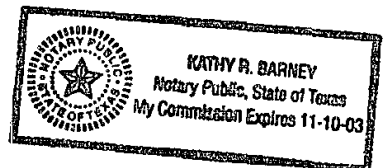

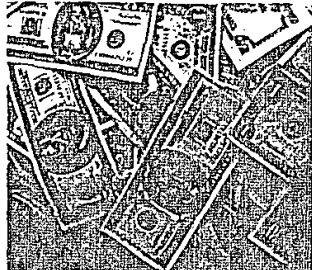
**EDUCATION.**

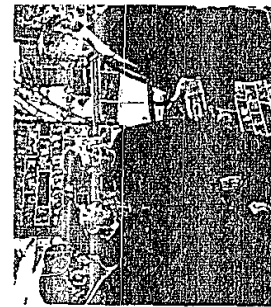
**TAXES.**

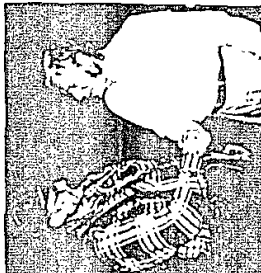
**SOCIAL SECURITY.**

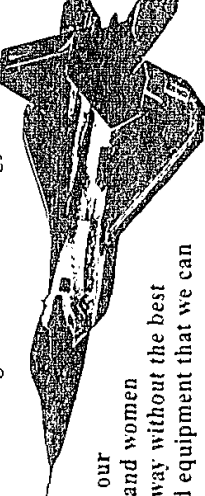
**CRIME.**
