SUBJECT: REFERRAL OF LINCOLN CLUB OF RIVERSIDE COUNTY

This is a combined Non-Filer/Chronic Late Filer referral of the Lincoln Club of Riverside County ("the Committee") for failure to file the 1997 Year End and 1998 April, July Quarterly and October Quarterly Reports within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of the Non-Filer Notices.

Subsequent to the sending of the Chronic Late Filer Notice referencing the 1997 Year End and 1998 April and July Quarterly Reports, the Committee submitted late the 1998 October Quarterly, 12 Day Pre-General and 30 Day Post-General Reports. According to the 1997-1998 RAD Review and Referral Procedures for Unauthorized Committees further examination is required by your office.

The Committee was referred for a possible 2 U.S.C. 438(b) audit covering the 1997-98 election cycle. The Commission voted on October 19, 1999 not to audit the Committee (see RAD Referral #A99-83).

- III. BACKGROUND:

Failure to Timely File Reports and Chronic Late Filing of Reports

Lincoln Club of Riverside County ("the Committee") has failed to file six (6) Reports of Receipts and Disbursements in a timely manner for the 1997-1998 election cycle (see chart on page 3). The reports were filed between sixty (60) and three hundred and sixty-six (366) days late.

On December 30, 1996, a Prior Notice was sent to the Committee informing it that the 1997 Year End Report was due on January 31, 1998 (Attachment 2). The Prior Notice sent on December 29, 1997 provided the due date for this report as well as the due dates for all 1998 reports (Attachment 3). A Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee via mailgram for the 1997 Year End Report on February 23, 1998 (Attachment 4).

On March 20, 1998, a Prior Notice was sent to the Committee informing it that the 1998 April Quarterly Report was due on April 15, 1998 (Attachment 5). A Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee via mailgram on May 7, 1998 (Attachment 7).

On June 19, 1998, a Prior Notice was sent to the Committee informing it that the 1998 July Quarterly Report was due on July 15, 1998 (Attachment 8). A Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee via mailgram on August 7, 1998 (Attachment 9).

On August 14, 1998, a Chronic Late Filer Notice was sent to the Committee for failing to file the 1997 Year End and 1998 April and July Quarterly Reports in a timely manner (Attachment 10). The Notice advised the Committee that any additional late filing of reports may result in legal enforcement action. Subsequent to the mailing of the Chronic Late Filer Notice, the Committee failed to file the 1998 October Quarterly, the 12 Day Pre-General Report and the 30 Day Post-General Reports in a timely manner.

On September 18, 1998, a Prior Notice was sent to the Committee informing it that the 1998 October Quarterly Report was due on October 15, 1998 (Attachment 11). A Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee via mailgram on November 4, 1998 (Attachment 13).

The Committee filed the 1997 Year End and 1998 April Quarterly, July Quarterly, October Quarterly, 12 Day Pre-General and combined 1998 30 Day Post-General and Year End Reports on February 1, 1999 (Attachment 16). Furthermore, the combined 1998 30 Day Post-General Report omitted some of the activity for the period from October 15, 1998, through October 17, 1998.

Throughout 1998 and 1999, the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst attempted to contact the treasurer of the Committee for failure to file its reports. These attempts were made as follows: on March 20 and 24, 1998 for the 1997 Year End Report; on June 1 and 2, 1998 for the 1997 Year End and 1998 April Quarterly Reports; on August 31, 1998 for the 1997 Year End and 1998 April and July Quarterly Reports; on November 30 and December 1, 1998 for the 1997 Year End and 1998 April, July and October Quarterly Reports; and on February 1 and 2, 1999 for the 1997 Year End Report as well as all 1998 Quarterly Reports and 30 Day Post-General Report. In each of these cases, no one answered, and there was no answering machine (Attachment 6).

³ The Committee did not file a separate 1998 30 Day Post-General Report. Instead it filed two 1998 Year End Reports: one with the coverage dates of 10/18/98-12/31/98 and the other with the coverage dates of 11/24/98-12/31/98. Both were filed on 2/1/99. Thus, there was a gap in coverage dates and some activity from 10/15/98-10/17/98.






