I. ACTIONS RECOMMENDED:

Accept the attached, signed counterproposed conciliation agreement with the Lincoln Club of Riverside County and Kathleen A. Daley, as treasurer and close the file in this matter.

II. BACKGROUND

On May 16, 2000, the Commission found reason to believe that the Lincoln Club of Riverside County and Kathleen A. Daley, as treasurer ("Respondents" or "Committee"), violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) by failing to timely file their 1997 Year End, 1998 April Quarterly, July Quarterly, October Quarterly, 12 Day Pre-General and 30 Day Post-General Reports. The Commission also determined to enter into pre-probable cause conciliation and approved a conciliation agreement

III. DISCUSSION

Attached is a conciliation agreement which has been signed by Kathleen A. Daley, treasurer of the Lincoln Club of Riverside County.
