

CONSENT TO EXTEND TIME

In order to allow time for the Federal Election Commission to participate in pre-probable cause conciliation negotiations, rather than issuing a probable cause brief in this matter, Herbert Wolfe ("Respondent") hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action that the Federal Election Commission might institute against him in the above-referenced matter. By this agreement, Respondent tolls the statute of limitations for a period of sixty (60) days.

This action will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable, in this matter. There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the consent of the Respondent.
