On behalf of the Democratic Party of Illinois, Michael J. Madigan, its chair, and myself, as treasurer, I hereby submit this response to the Commission's September 17, 2002 correspondence regarding the above referenced Complaint.

I. Introduction.

The Commission's correspondence indicates that it has found "reason to believe" that the Democratic Party of Illinois ("State Party") violated three provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act and also a provision of the Commission's regulations promulgated under the Act. For the reasons set forth in greater detail below, the State Party believes it did not violate any statutory or regulatory provisions because all the allegations involving the State Party are predicated on the false assertion that the State Party is affiliated with either the Rock Island County

Democratic Central Committee ("Rock Island Committee") or the 17th District Victory Fund ("Victory Fund").

In fact, the State Party is not affiliated with either of these committees, or any other political committee. The State Party and its officers and employees have no on-going relationship with any of these political committees. The State Party does not in any way direct the activities of any of these other committees. The State Party does not finance any of these committees (it has made only one nonfederal contribution from 1998 through 2000 to the Rock Island Committee), nor does it play any part in establishing or maintaining these committees.

II. Discussion.

1. Affiliation with the Rock Island Committee.

The Commission's correspondence indicates a reason to believe the State Party violated 2 U.S.C. 433(b)(2) by failing to report affiliation with the Rock Island Committee. The Commission's letter begins by setting forth all of the Rock Island Committee's conduct that caused it to become a federal political committee. The Commission notes at least two mailers that the Rock Island Committee sent out containing express advocacy for Lane Evans, and also notes that the Rock Island Committee may have purchased radio advertising expressly advocating the election of Lane Evans. While these facts, if true, could cause the Rock Island Committee to qualify as a federal committee, they do not in any way establish any affiliation with the State Party.

In fact, the State Party was completely unaware of the federal campaign activity in which the Rock Island Committee was engaged prior to receipt of the Commission's correspondence regarding this matter. The State Party (including all of its officers and employees) played no role in creating or distributing the mailers or the radio advertisements. The State Party was not consulted regarding their production, content or distribution timing or method. The State Party did not in any way finance the advertisements or mailers or exercise any control over the Rock Island Committee's funds that may have produced these materials.

(a) Contributions to the Rock Island Committee.

The Commission also notes a \$2,000 contribution from the State Party to the Rock Island Committee on 1998. In fact, the State Party made a similar contribution to the Rock Island Committee in 2000; a \$5,000 contribution on November 2, 2000. Both of these contributions were made from the State Party's "Nonfederal" account. This further demonstrates that the State Party was unaware of the Rock Island Committee's federal activity. Had the State Party been aware of the Rock Island Committee's federal activity, the State Party's contribution would have been made from the State Party's "Federal" account according to the appropriate allocation regulations.

Instead, the once every two years contributions from the State Party to the Rock Island Committee were simply donations to help elect Democrats to local offices. The State Party routinely makes such contributions to many county Democratic Committees. Every such donation is intended

to be used exclusively for nonfederal election purposes and, to the best of the State Party's knowledge, no such committees engage in any federal election activity.

(b). The Role of John Gianulus in the State Party.

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The Commission next indicates that the Rock Island Committee Chair, John Gianulus, was once the State Party's treasurer and that fact may indicate a possible connection between the committees. Mr. Gianulus, however, has not held that position for several years and did not hold it during either the 1998 or the 2000 election campaigns. In fact, during the entire tenure of the current State Party's administration, Mr. Gianulus has neither been an officer nor an employee of the State Party. Additionally, following Chairman Madigan's election as State Party Chair, Mr. Gianulus was replaced as treasurer. The fact that Mr. Gianulus was removed from his position with the State Party and has not held any other office or employment should, in fact, indicate a lack of connection between the committees.

(c). The Coordinated Campaign.

The Commission next indicates that affiliation may be evidenced by their "joint participation" in the Democratic National Committees "Coordinated Campaign" program. The State Party did not participate in a coordinated campaign in 1998. The State Party did participate in a coordinated campaign in 2000, but the Rock Island Committee did not participate in that coordinated campaign. On the contrary, the State Party's coordinated campaign plan (a copy is enclosed) specifically recognized that "although there are two Tier One targeted Congressional races in Illinois

(10th and 17th CDs), these candidates chose to pursue their own coordinated campaigns within their districts which prohibits us from direct coordinated activity in these areas."

The State Party's coordinated campaign did not involve any staff in Rock Island County and did not in any way control the Rock Island Committee's activities. Moreover, the State Party, either through its coordinated campaign or otherwise, did not have any approval power over any of the Rock Island Committee's activities. The fact that the State Party was completely unaware of the either the radio advertisements or the mailers containing federal election activity further demonstrates the State Party's lack of control over the Rock Island Committee.

(d) The State Party's Involvement with the Rock Island Committee.

During both 1998 and 2000 campaigns, the State Party had dedicated staff located in and around Rock Island County. In each instance, however, all State Party staff were specifically assigned to work solely for a candidate seeking a State office. In fact, all such staff were specifically prohibited, as a term of their employment contract from doing work on behalf of any candidate for any federal office.

In 1998, the State Party assigned David Clarkin, Mark Mahoney, Patricia McAdams and Dan Teehey to direct the campaign of Mike Beaty, the Democratic nominee for an Illinois House of Representatives seat. None of these staff people were assigned to work for the entire Democratic ticket, but were assigned solely to direct this State legislative campaign. In fact, the State Party

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treated 100% of these staff salaries as in-kind contributions from the State Party to the Beaty campaign. The notices of these in-kind contributions are attached.

Similarly, in 2000 the State Party assigned certain staff people to work on the campaign of Thomas Kilbride, the Democratic nominee for the Illinois Supreme Court from a district that includes Rock Island County. Those staff people were Michelle Paul, Ryan Wolfe, Jennifer Briggs, Mike Thompson, Eric Madiar, Dave Clarkin, Joe Reinholtz and Mike Thompson (assigned to Rock Island County), Claire Maroney, Eric Lane and Hadiya Drew (assigned to Will County), Jennifer Shehorn and Deshana Fournoy (assigned to Peoria County). Again, the entirety of the staff salaries were treated as in-kind contributions to the Kilbride for Supreme Court Committee (copies of the notices are attached) and these staff were likewise prohibited from working for any federal candidate by terms of their employment contract. The State Party had no staff assigned to the coordinated campaign in Rock Island County.

Needless to say, the State Party staff assigned to these state legislative and judicial races met with local Party officials, including those in Rock Island County, for the purposes of furthering the campaigns to which they were assigned. However, none of the staff assigned to these nonfederal races played any role in developing, implementing or financing the Rock Island Committee's activities for any other candidates.

(e). Coordinated Party Expenditures.

The Commission alleges that the costs of the mailers and radio advertisements purchased by the Rock Island Committee may have caused the State Party to exceed its spending authority limit for Lane Evans. Again, this assertion is based upon the incorrect assumption that the State Party and the Rock Island Committee are affiliated. Because the State Party and the Rock Island Committee are not affiliated, the Rock Island Committee's expenditures should not be treated as made pursuant to § 441a(d).

The Commission notes that, pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 110.7(c), the State Party is responsible for ensuring that all expenditures made by subordinate committees do not exceed the § 441a(d) limitations. In this case, the State Party was not only unaware that the Rock Island Committee was making any expenditures in support of a federal candidate, but also the State Party had good reason to believe that the Rock Island Committee was not making such expenditures. Specifically, the Rock Island Committee was not, at any time relevant to this matter, registered as a political committee with the Commission, but was registered with the Illinois State Board of Elections. Accordingly, the State Party reasonably believed that the Rock Island Committee was engaging in activities limited to supporting candidates for state and local offices.

If the Rock Island Committee had been registered with the Commission, the State Party would have known that it was engaging in federal activity, and the State Party would have taken appropriate steps to ensure that the § 441a(d) limitations were not exceeded. However, acting upon the reasonable belief that no subordinate committees were making unauthorized expenditures, the

State Party transferred its § 441a(d) spending authority to the Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee ("DCCC").¹ The State Party's transfer of all of its § 441a(d) authority to the DCCC is further evidence that the State Party simply had no involvement or knowledge in the Rock Island County's activities. Had the State Party known that the Rock Island Committee (if they were affiliated) was making § 441a(d) expenditures, it could have very simply deducted the appropriate amount of those expenditures from its assignment letter to the DCCC.

2. The 17th District Victory Fund.

The Commission also found reason to believe that the State Party was affiliated with the Victory Fund. However, the State Party had even less of a connection with the Victory Fund than it did with the Rock Island Committee. The State Party has never had any financial dealings with the Victory Fund, and the two committees have never had any concurrent officers and have never coordinated their activities. Accordingly, the State Party is not affiliated with the Victory Fund.

(a). Common Officers.

In support of its finding, the Commission begins with the fact, similar to the Rock Island Committee, that John Gianulus, the Victory Fund Chair, is a former treasurer of the State Party. As indicated above, the fact that Mr. Gianulus was replaced as State Party treasurer in April, 1998, should serve as evidence of a lack of affiliation.

¹ The State Party's letter assigning its § 441a(d) spending authority to the DCCC for 2000 is enclosed. The State Party has no record of a similar assignment in 1998, although such an assignment may have been made.

Additionally, while a common officer may serve as evidence of affiliation (11 C.F.R. 100.5(g)), the State Party and the Victory Fund never had a common officer. Mr. Gianulus registered the Victory Fund with the Commission on June 22, 1998, several months after he was removed as State Party treasurer. While evidence of common officers may indicate affiliation, the regulations can only be reasonably interpreted to mean concurrent common officers, and not past officers. If the latter interpretation is correct, then every State Party committee would be affiliated with every committee in which any former officer later became involved.

(b). The Coordinated Campaign.

The State Party, as indicated above, participated in a coordinated campaign in 2000, but not in 1998. The Victory Fund did not participate in the coordinated campaign. If the Victory Fund indicated that it did participate in a coordinated campaign, it must be referring to a different campaign apparatus. The Commission also quotes the Evans Campaign as indicating that it "met periodically with the [Victory Fund]." No State Party staff assigned to its coordinated campaign attended any such meeting. The only State Party staff that would have met with any representative of the Victory Fund would have been the same personnel listed above, and for the sole purpose of advancing the campaign interests of State House candidate Mike Beaty (1998) or Supreme Court candidate Thomas Kilbride (2000).

The Commission goes on to conclude that the State Party "would have exerted considerable control via approval power" over any of the Victory Fund's activities. In fact, the State Party exerted

no control over the Victory Fund because neither the State Party Chair nor myself, as Treasurer, knew of the Victory Fund's existence prior to the receipt of the Complaint in this matter.

(c) Coordinated Party Expenditures.

Because the Victory Fund is not a subordinate committee affiliated with the State Party, it has no authority to make expenditures pursuant to § 441a(d). The Commission notes several facts that may lead to the conclusion that the Victory Fund and the Lane Evans Committee acted in coordination, such as shared office locations and weekly meeting. The Commission does not, however, assert that the State Party acted in coordination with either the Victory Fund or the Evans Committee.

Moreover, the Commission does not assert that the Victory Fund made any expenditures that could be considered subject to § 441a(d), but rather states that "if the Victory Fund made coordinated expenditures" those expenditures would be attributed to the State Party's limitations. The State Party is unaware of any § 441a(d) expenditures, or for that matter any other expenditures, made by the Victory Fund.

III. Conclusion.

The State Party is not affiliated with either the Rock Island Committee or the Victory Fund. The State Party has no common officers with either committee. The State Party made two nonfederal contributions to the Rock Island Committee over a four year period and had no financial dealings with the Victory Fund. The State Party did not jointly participate in a coordinated

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campaign with either the Rock Island Committee or the Victory Fund in 1998 or 2000. The State Party did not exercise any control or approval over either committees' activities. In fact, the State Party officers were unaware that the Rock Island Committee was engaging in any federal election activity or that the Victory Fund even existed. Accordingly, the State Party respectfully submits that the presumption of affiliation is inapplicable in this instance.

As a result, the State Party did not fail to report either the Rock Island Committee or the Victory Fund as affiliated committees. The State Party also did not make expenditures exceeding the limitations imposed by § 441a(d). Finally, the State Party, because it is not affiliated with either of these committees, does not share a contribution limitation with the Victory Fund and did not accept excess contributions.

For the reasons enumerated above, the State Party respectfully requests that the Commission take no further action on this Complaint.
