6. Find reason to believe that Clinton/Gore '96 General Committee, Inc., and Joan Pollitt, as treasurer, accepted a prohibited contribution from M.S. Green - Little Rock Corporation d/b/a the Excelsior Hotel in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a), but take no further action and close the file as it relates to the Clinton/Gore '96 General Committee, Inc., and Joan Pollitt, as treasurer.
7. Find reason to believe that World Wide Travel Services, Inc., made a prohibited contribution to the Clinton/Gore '96 General Committee, Inc., in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a), but take no further action and close the file as it relates to World Wide Travel Services, Inc.
8. Find reason to believe that M.S. Green - Little Rock Corporation d/b/a the Excelsior Hotel made a prohibited contribution to the Clinton/Gore '96 General Committee, Inc., in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a), but take no further action and close the file as it relates to the M.S. Green - Little Rock Corporation d/b/a the Excelsior Hotel.

2. Find no reason to believe that AT&T Corporation made a prohibited contribution to the Clinton/Gore '96 General Committee, Inc., in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a), and close the file as it relates to AT&T Corporation.
