AR 99-08

On July 11, 2000, the Commission considered recommendations contained in the First General Counsel's Report. The Commission held a separate vote on recommendations relating to an extension of credit by AT&T Corporation to the Clinton/Gore '96 General Committee, Inc. (the "Committee") and found no reason to believe that the Committee or AT&T Corporation violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a). However, the Commission failed to vote on recommendations to approve the appropriate letters and close the file as it relates to the Committee and AT&T Corporation. Thus, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission approve the appropriate letters and close the file in AR 99-08 as it relates to Clinton/Gore '96 General Committee, Inc. and Joan Pollitt, as treasurer, and AT&T Corporation.
