On September 13, 2000, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission determined to enter into negotiations directed toward reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. On that same day you were sent a conciliation agreement offered by the Commission in settlement of this matter.

To date, you have not responded to the proposed agreement. Please note that the 30 day conciliation period has expired. However, in the interest of prompt settlement you will be given five additional days to accept the proposed conciliation agreement. Unless we receive a response from you within five days, this Office will consider these negotiations terminated and will proceed to the next stage of the enforcement process.
