Dear Mr. Golding:

You were previously notified that on January 10, 2001, the Federal Election Commission found probable cause to believe that Golding 98 Congress and William L. Golding, as treasurer, for whom you have been designated as representative, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(i), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, in connection with the captioned matter. As a result of our inability to settle this matter through conciliation within the allowable time period, the Commission has authorized the General Counsel to institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court.
