On October 22, 2001, your clients, the National Republican Senatorial Committee and its treasurer, and the McCollum Victory Committee and D. Jan McBride, as treasurer, were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that they violated 2 U.S.C. § 433(b)(2) and 11 CFR § 102.17(c). On December 14, 2001, you submitted a response to the Commission's reason to believe findings. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on November 17, 2004, to take no further action against your clients, and closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003).
