This letter is in response to your letter dated March 27, 2001 to Steven J. Hamerslag, Registered Agent for j2 Global Communications, Inc. ("j2"). We have reviewed your letter as well as the enclosures, and are writing this letter to demonstrate that no action should be taken against j2 in this matter.

j2, through its websites j2.com and efax.com, provides an Internet-based facsimile and voicemail service. We provide our customers unique telephone numbers through which they can send and receive faxes and voicemails through the Internet. j2 acts simply as a conduit for our customers to send and receive this information. We neither review nor save any of this data.

The only way that j2 could potentially be involved in this matter is if someone used one of our telephone numbers to send the facsimile messages and/or voicemail messages enclosed with your letter. As j2 acts simply as a conduit for the delivery of messages over the Internet, j2 has no responsibility for the messages sent.

If j2's services were used to send messages that violate the law, we would be happy to provide you relevant customer data upon receipt of a subpoena requesting this information.
