Citizens for Greenleaf received a complaint designated Matter Under Review (MUR 5111) by the Federal Election Commission. We responded to this complaint on November 14, 2000 and requested that the Commission dismiss this case.

In further reviewing our response, we would like to amend Item 3 on Page 5. The item should read as follows:

3. Party for supporters, contributors and friends

On May 31, 1999, Citizens hosted an outdoor party for supporters, contributors and friends of Senator Stewart Greenleaf. For this event, Citizens spent \$367.03 renting outdoor equipment. In addition, Citizens spent \$374.82 on food and supplies. The total expenses amounted to \$741.85. These expenses related to the state campaign committee and are not regulated by federal law.
