Dear Mr. Willard:

As we discussed in our phone conversation yesterday, you will now be representing the Federer for Congress Committee and its treasurer in these matters. As noted in the letter that accompanied the May 4, 2004 General Counsel's Brief sent to your clients' former counsel, Mr. Thomas Federer, before granting any request for an extension of time to respond to the brief, this Office would require that your clients execute an agreement to extend the statute of limitations.


As you may know, this Office previously agreed to a 20-day extension of time in which to file a response to the brief, extending the original due date of May 21, 2004 to June 10, 2004. That extension was granted based on former counsel's representation that the Respondents were seeking Washington, D.C. counsel. A statute of limitations tolling agreement entitled "Consent to Extend Time to Institute a Civil Law Enforcement Suit" was executed on May 19, 2004. To accommodate your request for an additional extension of time, until June 17, 2004, the attached tolling agreement tolls all applicable statute of limitations for an additional seven (7) days. The attached agreement together with the aforementioned tolling agreement and another agreement signed on September 22, 2003 toll all applicable statute of limitations in these matters for sixty-seven (67) days.

Please sign the attached tolling agreement and return a copy to me by facsimile by close of business tomorrow, June 10, 2004. My fax number is (202) 219-3923. Once we receive the faxed copy of the signed agreement and the designation of counsel form that was faxed to you earlier today, we will send a letter granting your extension request. You may then mail or hand-deliver the originals of the signed tolling agreement and designation of counsel form.
