Dear Ms. Anderson:

On November 1, 2000, the Federal Election Commission notified the National Republican Congressional Committee, and you, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On June 1, 2001, the Federal Election Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by you and other Respondents, that there is no reason to believe that the National Republican Congressional Committee, and you, as treasurer violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441a(a)(2)(A) or 441a(d)(3)(b), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter. The General Counsel's Report, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is enclosed for your information.


The confidentiality provisions at 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12) no longer apply and this matter is now public.
