I received your letter dated November 29, 2000 requesting an extension of time until January 2, 2001 to submit materials in response to the Commission's finding of reason to believe against your client, Missouri Democratic State Committee and Donna Knight, as treasurer.

The Office of General Counsel has agreed to grant the extension request to January 2, 2001 upon the condition that your client consent to toll the statute of limitations and extend time to institute a civil law enforcement suit. Signing the consent waiver form extends the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for a period of twenty (20) days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter.
