5. Approve the Factual and Legal Analyses, as recommended in the General Counsel's Report dated July 10, 2002, subject to the following revisions:
  - a) Delete the Factual and Legal Analysis for Precision List, Inc.;
  - b) Delete any references to Precision List, Inc., in the Factual and Legal Analyses for the other respondents; and
  - c) Amend language, as appropriate, in the Factual and Legal Analyses pursuant to the meeting discussion.
6. Approve the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Mason, McDonald, Sandstrom, Smith, Thomas, and Toner voted affirmatively for the decision.
