As you know, from previous correspondence this firm represents the Performance Group. In response to the complaint by the Colorado Reform Party, I would only state that the complaint seems to be directed against the Reform Party 2000 Convention Committee for expenditures it allegedly made. I don't believe the complaint alleges any wrongdoing against my client under the FECA or the Fund Act. Our response would be the same as contained in my letter to you dated January 26, 2001 (MUR5164), copy enclosed. Additionally, I would ask you to note that all expenditures by the Reform Party to my client were made prior to the Long Beach Convention. The complaint from the Colorado Reform Party, that these expenditures were made in connection with the Long Beach, California Party Convention, is not true, because the expenditures were made months prior to the Convention.
