



**CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission's agreement to further extend the period for post-probable cause conciliation discussions in this matter, Respondents Steve Barger, Don Mitchell, and Tom Schulz, hereby consent to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MUR 5268 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(6) from August 13, 2004, through August 31, 2004. This action will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement pertaining to any violation in this matter for which the statute of limitations had not already run on August 13, 2004, for an additional eighteen (18) days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable, in these matters.
