CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission's agreement to further extend the period for post-probable cause conciliation discussions in this matter, Respondent Kentucky State District Council of Carpenters, now known as the Indiana-Kentucky Regional Council of Carpenters, hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MUR 5268 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(6) from September 1, 2004 through September 30, 2004. This action will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement pertaining to any violation in this matter for which the statute of limitations had not already run on September 1, 2004, for an additional thirty (30) days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable, in these matters.
