On July 26, 2002 your client, Kushner Companies, was notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that Kushner Companies violated, 2 U.S.C. §§ 441b(a) and 441f. On November 12, 2002, your client submitted a response to the Commission's reason to believe finding. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on June 22, 2004, to take no further action against Kushner Companies, and closed the file in this matter.
