On July 26, 2002 your client, Scott Zecher, was notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that he violated, 2 U.S.C. §§ 441b(a) and 441f. On September 23, 2002, your client submitted a response to the Commission's reason to believe finding. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on June 22, 2004, to take no further action against Scott Zecher, and closed the file in this matter.
