

On October 2, 2002, the Federal Election Commission notified the Carole Migden Leadership Committee and you, as treasurer, and Re-Elect Assemblywoman Carole Migden and you, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On January 26, 2004, the Commission found, on the basis of information in the complaint, that there is no reason to believe the Carole Migden Leadership Committee and you, as treasurer, or Re-Elect Assemblywoman Carole Migden and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 441f. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003). A copy of the General Counsel's Report is enclosed for your information.
