On November 1, 2002, the Federal Election Commission notified Representative Nancy Pelosi and Nancy Pelosi for Congress and Paul F. Pelosi, as treasurer, your clients, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act").


On August 25, 2003, the Commission, found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by you, that there is no reason to believe Representative Nancy Pelosi violated any provision of the Act or Commission regulations in connection with this matter, and close its file as to her. On the same date, the Commission dismissed the complaint with respect to Nancy Pelosi for Congress and Paul F. Pelosi, as treasurer, and closed its file as to them.

The Commission reminds you that the confidentiality provisions of 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12)(A) remain in effect, and that this matter is still open with respect to other respondents. The Commission will notify you when the entire file has been closed, at which time you will be sent a copy of the dispositive General Counsel's Report.
