At the direction of Ms. Alva Smith, I am writing to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Clark for Congress campaign regarding the contributions received from Team Majority PAC.

On September 9th, 2002 we received a \$1,000 contribution from Team Majority PAC. Prior to accepting the contribution, we obtained from the FEC website the FEC ID number for the committee and verified that the status of the PAC was a qualified, multi-candidate committee and unaffiliated with another committee.

On October 21st, 2002 we received an additional contribution for \$2,500 from Team Majority PAC.

Upon receiving a call from the Team Majority Treasurer, Leo McCarthy, informing us of the challenge to the Team Majority PAC unaffiliated status as affiliated with the PAC for the Future PAC, a committee that had already given the maximum allowable contribution for both Primary and General elections, we decided to immediately refund the accepted contributions.

On October 25, 2002 we issued a refund check of \$1,000 (check number 702) to the Team Majority PAC. On October 25, 2002 we issued a refund check of \$2,500 (check number 705) to the Team Majority PAC. Copies of both checks are attached.

The Post General Election FEC disclosure report, due December 5, 2002, will contain this information as well.
