Dear Mr Jordan,

I am responding to the above referenced complaint within the allotted time of 15 days from the receipt of your letter I'm sorry that both of us have to waste our time and taxes to address this unfounded complaint

I have followed the regulations of the FEC in contributing to the John Swallow for Congress campaign as they have been explained to me Although an individual can only contribute \$1000 00 per election cycle, we have three election cycles during an election year in Utah allowing an individual to contribute up to \$3000 00 annually, if they so desire I contributed \$1300 00 to John Swallow's campaign in 2002 through three contributions Each was made in a separate election cycle and none was for more that \$1000 00 I have attached a spreadsheet giving the amounts and dates of the contributions I feel that I have not violated nor misconstrued any elections laws in this matter

I understand through Stanley de Waal, John Swallow's campaign treasurer, that there is designated counsel I hereby give notification that this counsel is able to act on my behalf before the Commission regarding MUR 5333
