Dear Mr. Ginsberg:

On November 21, 2002, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Danica M. Campbell, Michael Ellis and Monica Ellis, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.


On June 30, 2004, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by you, that there is no reason to believe Danica M. Campbell, Michael Ellis or Monica Ellis violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(1)(A). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter as it pertains to your clients.

The Commission reminds you that the confidentiality provisions of 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12)(A) remain in effect, and that this matter is still open with respect to other respondents. The Commission will notify you when the entire file has been closed, at which time you will be sent a copy of the dispositive General Counsel's Report.
