Dear Mr. Robinson:

On February 12, 2004, the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that Geoff Davis 2002 and Joe Green, as treasurer ("the Committee") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(3)(A). At your request, on November 9, 2004, the Commission determined to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe.

Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved in settlement of this matter. If your clients agree with the provisions of the enclosed agreement, please sign and return it, along with the civil penalty, to the Commission. In light of the fact that conciliation negotiations, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, are limited to a maximum of 30 days, you should respond to this notification as soon as possible.

If you have any questions or suggestions for changes in the agreement, or if you wish to arrange a meeting in connection with a mutually satisfactory conciliation agreement, please contact me after December 13, 2004 at (202) 694-1650. Prior to that date or if I am unavailable, please ask for Assistant General Counsel Sid Rocke.
