On November 26, 2002, the Federal Election Commission notified your client of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On June 21, 2004, the Commission found that, on the basis of the information in the complaint, the responses to the complaint, other information provided by your client, and information available to the public, there is no reason to believe Space Gateway Support, LLC violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441b or 441c. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
