On November 26, 2002, the Federal Election Commission notified your client of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On June 21, 2004, the Commission exercised its prosecutorial discretion and dismissed the complaint with respect to Yang Enterprises, Inc., and closed its file in this matter.
