On March 6, 2003, the Federal Election Commission accepted the signed conciliation agreement on behalf of your clients, First Consumers National Bank and Gregory Aube, as President, in settlement of violations of 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act").

Pursuant to the conciliation agreement, a civil penalty of \$16,500 was due thirty days from the date it was accepted by the Commission, or April 7, 2003. This Office received a check to cover the civil penalty, which the Commission attempted to deposit. Unfortunately, that check was returned to us "refer to maker," indicating that it was non-payable. A copy of that check is attached for your records. To obviate the need for any further proceedings, please resubmit a payment for \$16,500 immediately.
